The Auxiliary Project Review Committee meets two times a year to review applications from CVMC hospital departments, Woodridge and the CVMC office practices to fund projects and programs for furthering education and to better their patients' experience.

Special Projects: Each year, the Auxiliary gives consideration to funding a larger, special project with available funds.

Activities Committee – plans activities of the Auxiliary as needed.

Fundraising Committee – plans and coordinates fundraising activities.

Healing Needles Knitting Group – meets the first Wednesday of each month from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. at the hospital to knit comfort shawls for Palliative care, Afghans and items for Woodridge, as well as baby items for the Women & Children's Unit. Knitters also knit at home and contribute items.

Membership Committee – plan/assist with recruitment of new members.

Nominating Committee- meets annually to recruit Board members and compile a slate of officers.

Scholarship Committee - meets annually to award scholarships to local students and adult learners pursuing a degree in healthcare. Every year we chose 10 recipients to receive scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each. These are awarded to students from the Central Vermont service area as well as adult learners for the health care field.
